## **Combined/Joint Force Land Component Commander (C/JFLCC) Course**



**1. General.** The C/JFLCC Course is a senior level program held at the U.S. Army War College, Carlisle Barracks, Pennsylvania, twice each year. The course prepares senior officers to function effectively as land component commanders, or as senior staff in a joint/combined, interorganizational, and multinational (JIM) environment. These commanders will need to plan, prepare for, and execute land-centric operations that provide coalition commanders with capabilities to achieve policy objectives through sustained land dominance. This seminar-based course challenges senior officers to examine the key elements of developing and executing land component command functions at the theater level, in support of joint force commanders and in conjunction with air, maritime, space, and special operations functional commands. Senior mentors, who are retired general officers that have previously served as JFLCC commanders, guide course discussions. The course exercise challenges the attendees to issue guidance and devise solutions to designing, forming, controlling, protecting, operating, and sustaining a combined and joint land command at the theater and operational level of war.

**2. Purpose.** The C/JFLCC Course prepares one-, two-, and three-star officers of all six Services, and equivalent members of the Senior Executive Service, the Senior Foreign Service, and international officers for theater-level land component combat leadership and advisory positions. Directed by the U.S. Army Chief of Staff to build upon the positive lessons of Army and Marine Corps cooperation during overseas contingency operations, the course develops senior leader competency in operational level warfighting, with particular focus on combined arms maneuver and wide area security, conducted in joint, interorganizational, and multinational environments.

### **3. Objectives.**

- Design, plan, and prepare for the execution of unified land operations that support coalition and joint force commanders in the accomplishment of national security and international policy objectives.
- Form the land component command that executes theater-wide and multinational integrating functions of a C/JFLCC to set the theater.
- Understand the supporting and complementary capabilities that other functional commanders provide (combined force air component command (CFACC), combined/joint force maritime component command (C/JFMCC), combined force space component command (CFSCC), and combined/joint force special operations component command (C/JFSOCC)) and Unified Action partners.
- Conduct sustained unified land operations to win in a complex world.
